Kerinci Summit & *Danau Kaco*

Summit Indonesia's highest volcano & discover a mystical blue lake hidden in the heart of the rainforest.

Indonesia's highest volcano. A hidden blue lake. One extraordinary expedition.

This six-day expedition journeys into the highlands of Sumatra, combining Indonesia's highest volcano with one of its most mystical natural landmarks. Designed for active travelers, it takes you deep into Kerinci Seblat National Park — through tropical rainforest, high-altitude camps, and a sunrise summit ascent at 3,805 metres above sea level.

The journey then concludes at Danau Kaco, a hidden blue lake revered for its extraordinary clarity and tranquillity, before returning to Padang in comfort. Guided by experienced mountain crews and supported by carefully planned logistics, this expedition balances challenge, safety, and reward.

- Summit attack departs from Camp 1
Sunrise
- Reach the summit of Mount Kerinci —
3,805 m
- Panoramic sunrise above the clouds

- Transfer back to Kersik Tuo village

At 3,805 metres, Mount Kerinci is the highest volcano in Indonesia and the highest peak in Sumatra. Standing at the crater rim at dawn is a rare and unforgettable privilege.
